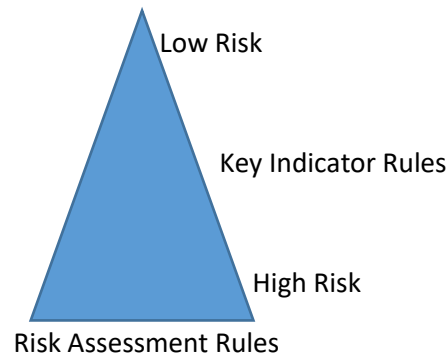


KIM x RAM: Key Indicator x Risk Assessment Metrics



The relationship between risk assessment rules (RAM) and key indicator rules (KIS) on a risk assessment scale. As one can see risk assessment rules would be the highest risk rules while key indicator rules are in the mid-range when it comes to a risk assessment scale. Risk assessment rules should have relatively low non-compliance or always be in compliance. Key indicator rules have some non-compliance but are not at a significant level of non-compliance as say low risk rules which may be out of compliance at a higher level.
